

## Instructions on How to Replace "*On Dafa—Lunyu*" in all your Dafa books.

### Supplies needed:

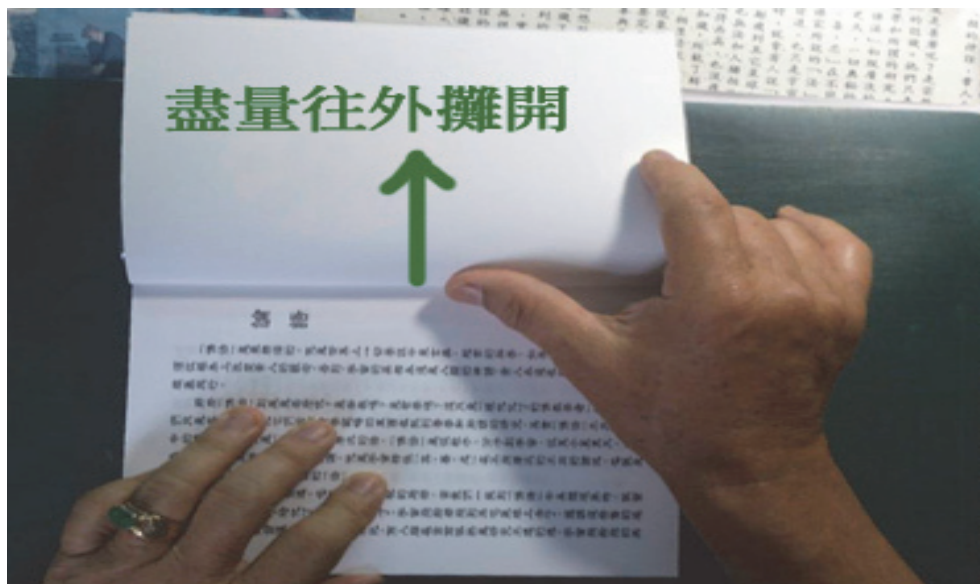
- Double-sided, 0.6 cm-wide tape with a peel off liner on one side
- Utility or exacto knife, or boxcutter
- A thick paper pad or several layers of cardboard
- A ruler or straight edge

### Steps:

1. Turn the book sideways and open to the Lunyu page.

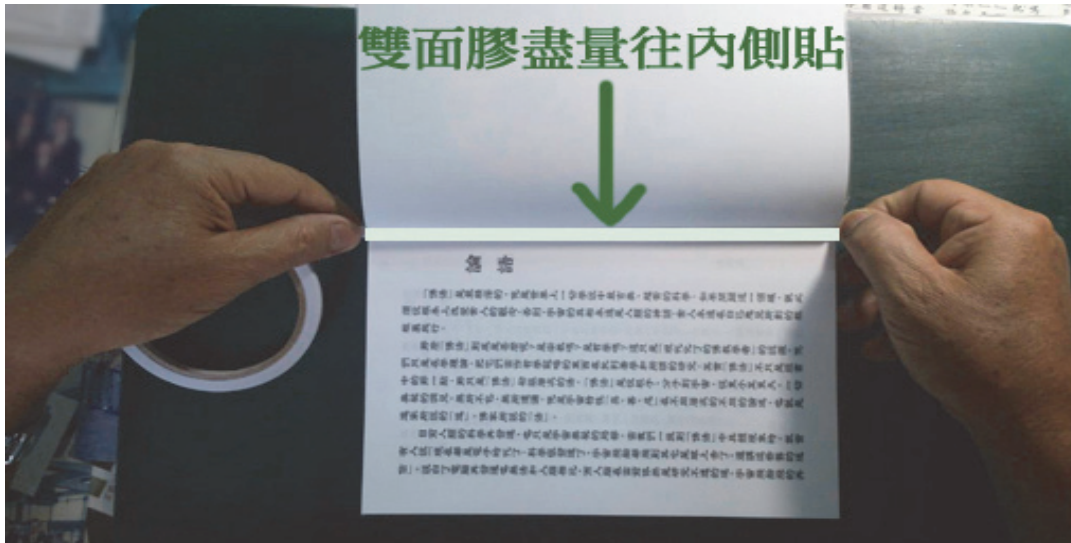


Spread the page out as flat as possible. Push the upper page away from the center crease to leave as



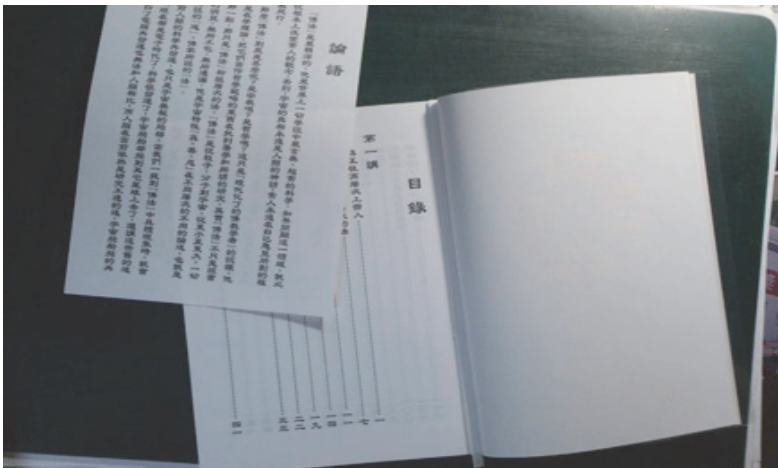
much space as possible on the Lunyu page.

2. Lay the sticky side of the double-sided tape across the page from side to side, as close to the center crease as possible, and adhere. Leave extra tape on each side. After making sure the tape is firmly adhered, cut off the excess.



3. Place cardboard or thick paper pad underneath the Lunyu page to be cut, and use a utility knife to cut out the page along the outer edge of the tape--that means there will be at least a 0.6 cm space to tape in the new page.

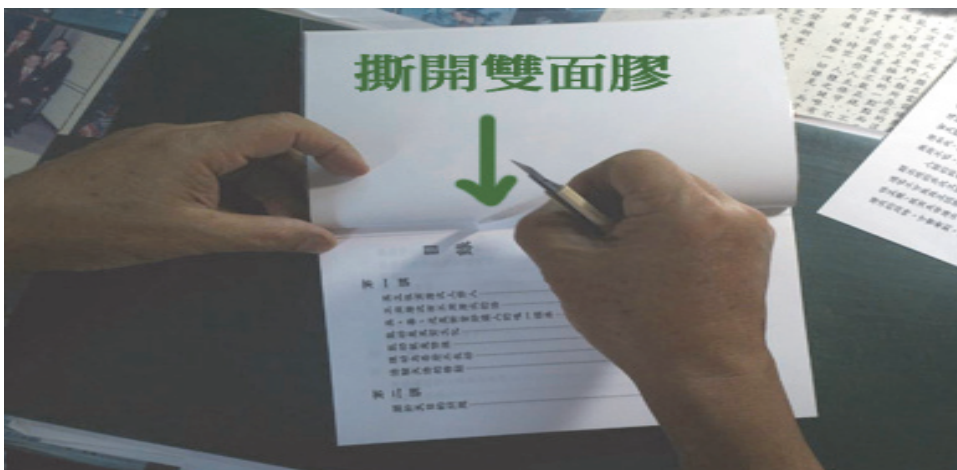




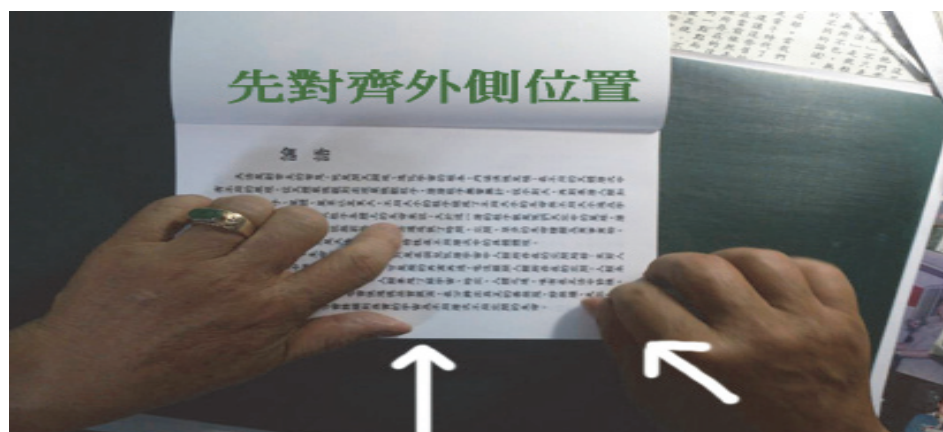
The old Lunyu page is cut out, and only the part with the double-sided tape remains.

4. Make certain the new Lunyu page will align vertically and horizontally.

5. Pull the liner off the front of the double-sided tape and slowly press the new Lunyu page onto the tape.

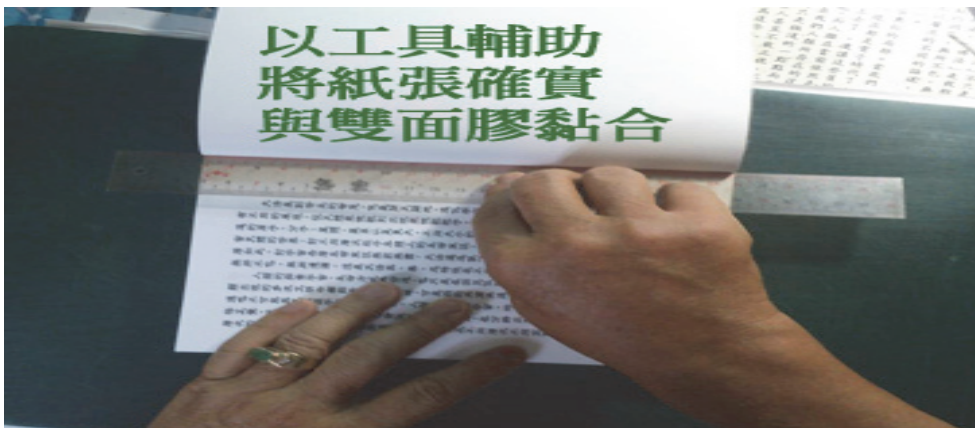


Pull the liner off the front of the double-sided tape

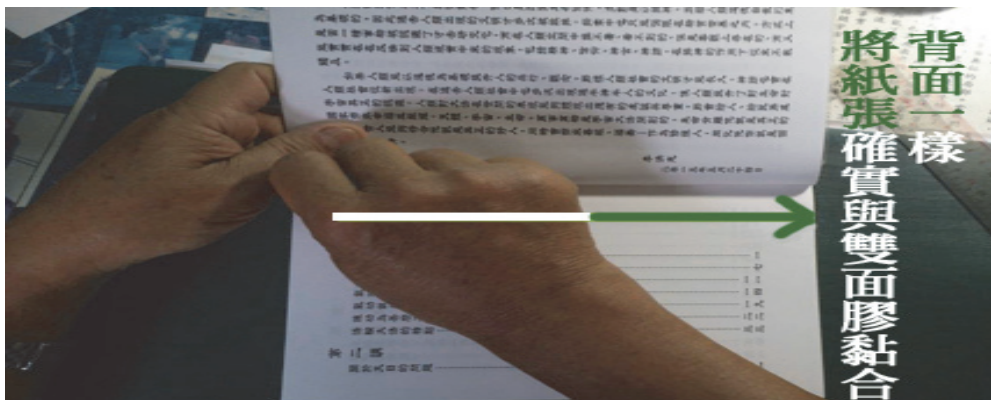


Put the new Lunyu page in place, aligning the page with the outer edges of the book vertically and horizontally





Use a ruler or straight edge to press the page to make sure it is firmly adhered to the double-sided tape.



On the back of the new Lunyu page, make sure the page is adhered to the double-sided tape.
